Television/Film focuses on the industries of television and film. The students will have the opportunity to gain hands on experiences with equipment used within the industry such as "Final Cut Pro" video editing software, Canon cameras, and Apple computer systems. This course studies the electronic mass media, it surveys the cultural industries from multiple perspectives, including history, economics, production processes, content, social effects, diversity, and globalization. Each student will be introduced to the following skills: storytelling, oral presentations, creative process of pre-production, production, post-production and collaborating with industry professionals on major projects.
